TE TĀONE O PAPAIOEA LOCATION

Palmerston North (or as we like to call it, Palmy) is the geographical centre of Aotearoa, 140km (87 miles) north of Wellington. It is part of New Zealand's second-largest population hub, with over one million people located within a two-hour (200km) radius. With small city benefits and big city ambition, Palmy has secured its place on the map as a creative and exciting city.

With a population of just under 90,000 people, Palmy is large enough to provide big-city facilities without the traffic congestion, access difficulties and cost associated with the larger cities. On arrival, this bonus is quickly apparent for visitors. The trip from the airport takes less than 10-minutes to hotel check-in. Palmerston North Airport has domestic services to all major cities,

as well as numerous provincial centres. It also had the record for being open the most days of any New Zealand airport. Palmy's central location is also well serviced by road and rail.

Everything is accessible at the Conference + Function Centre.
Conveniently located in the heart of the city, the centre offers the very best proximity to a range of superb hotels and motels and is surrounded by vibrant bars, cafes, restaurants, cultural institutions and retail shops.

As an added advantage we offer free car parking for all conference delegates and event attendees. Palmy is the centre of science, education, food innovation, and we have great rural connections. The Manawatū is also

Foyer


You'll be greeted with a spacious foyer and an abundance of natural light at our Palmy Conference + Function Centre. With its floor to ceiling windows, the foyer can be used as a pre-dinner function space, cocktail venue, additional exhibition space, event registration or for coffee breaks. Digital signage is used in the foyer to direct visitors to their venue.

Seminar Room

Just a few steps from the foyer, our Seminar Room has an attractive atmosphere with its high ceiling and natural light. The Seminar Room is a popular venue for meetings, luncheons, small dinners and cocktail parties, and is a great conference breakout room.

Elwood Room

Our Elwood Room is a versatile function space with three venue layout options. This fully airconditioned and attractively presented room is ideal for large meetings, exhibitions and trade shows, gala dinners, balls and all social occasions. The Elwood Room can comfortably host up to 550 people theatre style, or up to 350 for a banquet dinner. With portable staging and theatre lighting, it's easy to create drama to give your event an edge. A 47-inch LCD screen at the entrance to the Elwood Room displays event signage and branding. Flat floor loading and vehicle access is available from the loading dock. For smaller meetings and seminars, the room can be divided into Elwood Room 1 and Elwood Room 2 with our floor to ceiling black draping.

Conference Room

Our Conference Room is great for day-to-day business meetings, product launches and awards dinners, plus high profile events like keynote speakers and conference dinners. The Conference Room can accommodate up to 440 people theatre style and has a permanent stage with unobstructed sightlines. A floor to ceiling soundproof folding door can divide this space into two self-contained separate rooms – the Conference Room and the smaller Meeting Room.

Meeting Room




The Gallery

REHIA KI PAPAIOEA THINGS TO DO IN PALMY

Visit the Victoria Esplanade

Palmy's premier park and historic botanical gardens were established in 1897 and are home to the New Zealand Rose Trial Garden. Explore 26 hectares of bush walks, bike tracks and formal gardens. It has something for everyone in the family – thousands of mature trees, splendid roses, barbecues, croquet lawns... and the kids will love the Junior Road Safety Park, Wildbase Centre, miniature railway, playground and paddling pool.





New Zealand Rugby Museum

The New Zealand Rugby Museum contains New Zealand's biggest and most comprehensive collection of rugby memorabilia and records, including some of the world's rarest rugby artefacts.

You'll be rewarded with a trip back in time exploring the rich history and folklore of the nation's mighty game with an unmasking of its rugby heroes and legends.

Te Manawa Museum

Te Manawa is a cultural heart of the city that thrives on discovery – entertaining and inspiring people from all walks of life for more than 40 years. It's more than a museum and a gallery. It's a place where concepts and communities come together. With an engaging programme of exhibitions and events, as well as an extensive collection of taonga (treasures), Te Manawa offers a unique opportunity to experience and participate in the stories of our past, present and future.

National Wildbase Centre

Central Energy Trust Wildbase Recovery is a specialist centre providing shelter and care for native wildlife recovering after treatment at Massey University's Wildbase Hospital. The centre releases patients back into the wild once they have recovered. There are also resident animals at Wildbase including whio (blue duck), kereru, baby tuatara and red-crowned kakariki.





He Ara Kotahi

Our Manawatū River Framework recognises the importance of the awa to the city. The Framework is about enhancing physical connections with the river environment, expressing Rangitāne O Manawatū's connection with the awa, and creating a destination with things to do. The multiaward-winning project includes Ahimate Reserve, He Ara Kotahi bridge and Urban Eels platform. Ahimate is home to the city's most popular riverside beach, a dog agility park and fenced enclosure, mountain bike tracks and a natural playground. On He Ara Kotahi pathway you'll traverse dairy farms, forests, pā sites, a military camp, streams and a river in less than nine kilometres. Along the walkway, you will find Urban Eels. This award winning project is a hands-on experience that raises awareness of traditional cultural practices, and the significant mauri, or lifeforce, of this water. Ultimately, the Framework ensures each year there will be more things to do, and more people will spend time at our awa.
