

NGĀ HERE MŌ TE TOMO MAI KI CENTRAL ENERGY TRUST ARENA

E HERE ANA TE KATOAA E TOMO MAI ANA KI TE TAIWHANGA RĒHIA KI ĒNEI TAKOHANGA E WHAI AKE NEI. MĀ KONEI E HAUMARU AI, E HĀNEANEAA AI, E MANAWARŪ AI NGĀ KAIMĀTAKITAKI ME TE HUNGA WHAKATAETAE.

Te Mātai Tangata, Pēke Hoki

- Tērā pea ka mātaihia te hunga toro mai me ā rātou pēke i mua i te tomonga mai ki roto i Te Taiwhanga Rēhia.
- Tērā anō pea ka mātaihia i muri i te tauwhāinga, i te wā e wehe atu ana te tangata.
- Ina tohe mai tētahi, ka aukatia tana urunga mai ki Te Taiwhanga Rēhia, ā, ka tonoa ia kia wehe atu.
- Tērā pea ka mātaihia ngā waka e uru mai ana, e wehe atu ana rānei i Te Taiwhanga Rēhia.
- Ina kitea he tüemi kāore e whakaaehia ana, ka puritia e mātou.

Tikanga Kākahu

- Kia tika te āhua o ngā kākahu o ngā tāngata katoa e tomo mai ana ki Te Taiwhanga Rēhia. E haumarua ai, e manawa reka ai te katoa, me āta whai ēnei tikanga:
- Kāore e whakaaehia te wae māmōre.
- Kāua e whakaaturia he kōrero mōrihariha ki ngā kākahu.
- Kāore e whakaaehia he kahū tohu kēnge.
- Kāore e whakaaehia he kahutumu muramura, hāketō rānei, e pōhēhētia ai he kaimahi koe o konei, he kaimahi mate whawhati tata rānei.

Te Papa Tākaro

- Kāore e whakaaehia te hunga toro mai ki runga i te papa tākaro i mua i tētahi tauwhāinga, i te wā tonu o te tauwhāinga, i muri rānei. Ki te wāwāhia tēnei tūre, ka panaia te tangata, ā, ka utaina he pānui tūhiti ki runga i a ia.
- Mō ētahi tauwhāinga, tērā pea ka whakaaehia te hunga toro mai ki te papa tākaro, mēnā he tikiti houtupu tāna. Me āta whai ngā tohutohu a ngā kaimahi.

Tērā pea ka aukatia te tomo mai a te tangata ki Te Taiwhanga Rēhia mēnā

- E haurangi ana ki tā te karu titiro, e mate whakapōuau ana, e tutū ana rānei te whanonga.
- Ka kore e whāia ngā tono a ngā kirīhaumarua, a ngā kaimahi rānei.
- E whai ana kia kawea mai he tüemi kāore e whakaaehia ana.
- E whaimana tonu ana tētahi pānui tūhiti i tukuna i mua.
- Kāore e tika ana kia uru mai ki Te Taiwhanga Rēhia, arā pea, karekau he tikiti whaimana, he urunga whaimana rānei.

Ka tonoa te hunga toro mai kia maiki atu i Te Taiwhanga Rēhia mēnā

- He mōrihariha te reo.
- Ka whiua he kupu hanihani, ka kino rānei te whanonga.
- E haurangi ana.
- E mahi ana i tētahi mahi kāore e whakaaehia ana i roto i Te Taiwhanga Rēhia.
- Ka mākāia he tüemi ki hea rānei, ki te papa tākaro rānei (i te wā o te powaiwai Mēhikana hoki)
- Ka kore e ū ki ngā tūre me ngā Here o Te Taiwhanga Rēhia.

E whakaaehia ana te kawenga mai o ēnei kai me ēnei inu

- He pātara wai kirihou mēnā e taupokina pūmautia ana, ā, kāore e nui ake i te 1.5 rita.
- He inu waipiro-kore mēnā e taupokina pūmautia ana, ā, kāore e nui ake i te 500ml (e 4 te mōrahi mā ia tangata).
- He pātara wai kirihou kautahanga mēnā kāore e nui ake i te 1.5 rita – ka taea te whakaki i ngā puna wai o Te Taiwhanga Rēhia.
- He kai iti kua oti te whakarite i te kāinga, hei kai mā te tangata ake, pērā i te hanawiti, i te huarākau, i te keke me te titipi.
- He puoto puri mahana me te inu wera ki roto.
- Me rau atu ngā tüemi kai katoa ki te pēke iti kotahi, kia taea te waiho ki raro i tō tūru.
- He nui ngā wāhi hoko kai, inu hoki, huri noa i Te Taiwhanga Rēhia.

Kāore e whakaaehia te kawenga mai o ēnei ki roto i te Central Energy Trust Arena

- Te waipiro.
- He inu waipiro-kore nui ake i te 500ml (1.5 rita wai māori).
- He pātara karaehe.
- He ō rangaranga, pērā i te Makitānara, i te KFC, i te Subway, i te parehe, i te ika me te titipi.
- Te tokanga mātao mārō, te pēke nui rānei.
- Te whakapōuau taihara.
- He taonga puoro, he whākahā oro, he tukuoero rarahi rānei.
- He pūrere hopu mō te take arumoni.
- He waka pēpi.
- He kūrī, he mōkai kē atu rānei (e whakaaehia ana he kūrī tautāwhi mēnā e rehitalia ana).
- He tiripapā, he rama ahi, he pūtohu taihao rānei.
- He māripi, he rākau whawhai mōreareoa rānei.
- He papawira, he koneke, he kuta, he pahikara rānei.
- He tūru tū motuhake.
- He tohu, he kara rānei e mōhirariha ana, e weriweri ana, e hākiki ana rānei.
- He pou haki mēnā he roa ake i te kotahi mita.
- He tüemi kē atu ka aukatia e te hunga kaiwhakahāere o Te Taiwhanga Rēhia, inā ka whara pea te tangata, ka whakāhōhā, ka whakapōrearea rānei i te marea.

Te Momi Hikareti / Tākohu

- He wāhi auahi-kore te taiwhanga rēhia nei, otrā, kei muri i te ārewa nōhangā matua, kei te maiorō o te huarahi o Pascal hoki, ētahi wāhi e whakaaehia ana te momi hikareti, tākohu hoki. Kāua e momi hikareti, tākohu rānei i wāhi kē atu.

He Kupu Whānui

- He kāmera tūteki kei ngā wāhi katoa o Te Taiwhanga Rēhia, e haumarua ai te hunga toro mai.
- Kāua e noho, e tū rānei ki ngā kauhanganui, kāua hoki e tūkatū i ngā tomokanga, i ngā putanga ohotata rānei.
- Ina toro mai koe ki tētahi tauwhāinga mōreareoa, e mārama ana koe ki ngā tūraru e hāngai ana.
- He āhua mōreareoa ētahi tauwhāinga, ētahi takunetanga; me mārama koe ki ngā tūraru e hāngai ana.
- I ētahi tauwhāinga, kāore e whakaaehia kia puta koe ki waho me te hoki mai anō.
- Tērā pea ka tonoa koe ki te waiho i tō hamarara ki raro mēnā e aukatia ana i te tirohanga o tētahi atu.
- Kāore e whakaaehia he kāmera, he pūrere hopu kē atu rānei i ētahi tauwhāinga.
- Māu anō e kawea te tūraru ki ngā utauta ka mauria e koe ki roto i Te Taiwhanga Rēhia. Kāore he takohanga o te taiwhanga mēnā ka pakaru, ka ngaro, ka tāhaetia rānei ō utauta.
- Kāore e whakaaehia he pānui hokohoko, he momo whakatairanga kē atu rānei ki roto i Te Taiwhanga Rēhia (ki ōna papa tu waka anō hoki), kia whakaaehia rā anō e ngā kaiwhakahāere o Te Taiwhanga Rēhia. Ka tangohia e mātou ngā taonga e tukuna utukore ana ki te marea.
- Kāore e whakaaehia kia kawea atu he inu waipiro ki waho atu i Te Taiwhanga Rēhia. He wāhi waipiro-kore tēnei.
- Me āta tiaki e te hunga pakeke ngā tamariki kei raro iho i te 14 tau e haere mai ana i ō rātou taha.
- Ina tomo mai koe ki Te Taiwhanga Rēhia e whakaae ana kia whakaaahuangia koe i te kāmera ngū, ataata rānei, tērā pea ka whakamahia ēnei mō ngā kaupapa whakatairanga.

CENTRAL ENERGY TRUST ARENA CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ENTRY TO THE CENTRAL ENERGY TRUST ARENA IS SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS TO ENSURE THE SAFETY, COMFORT AND ENJOYMENT OF SPECTATORS AND ATHLETES.

Patron + Bag Searches

- All patrons and their possessions may be subject to searches before entering the Arena.
- Searches may also be carried out during an event and when leaving the Arena.
- Patrons who refuse to participate in searches may be denied entry to the Arena and asked to leave the venue.
- All vehicles entering and leaving the Arena may be searched.
- Prohibited items will be confiscated.

Dress Code

- All patrons entering the Central Energy Trust Arena must be appropriately dressed. For your own safety and the enjoyment of everyone, please comply with the following:
- No bare feet are permitted.
- No clothing or signs displaying offensive messages.
- No gang patches.
- No high visibility type vests or jackets that might be confused with venues staff and emergency services.

Playing Surface

- Patrons are not allowed on the playing area before, during or after sports events. Breach of this rule will result in eviction and the issuing of a trespass notice.
- For certain events, access to the playing field may be permitted to patrons holding valid tickets. Patrons must follow the directions of the staff.

Patrons may be refused entry to the Arena if they

- Appear intoxicated/under the influence of drugs or exhibit disorderly behaviour.
- Fail to comply with security or gate staff requests.
- Attempt to bring in prohibited items.
- Have been previously issued a trespass notice that still applies.
- Are not authorised to be in the Arena, for example, they have no valid entry ticket or accreditation pass.

Patrons will be asked to leave the Arena if they

- Use obscene language.
- Are verbally or physically abusive, or behave in a disorderly or offensive manner.
- Are intoxicated.
- Are carrying out unauthorised activities within the Arena.
- Throw items in the air or onto the pitch (including during Mexican waves).
- Fail to comply with any of the Arena Terms and Conditions.

Patrons may bring the following food + drink items

- Sealed clear plastic water bottles up to 1.5 litres.
- Sealed non-alcoholic drinks up to 500ml (max of 4 per person).
- Empty plastic water bottles may be filled in the Arena from water outlets provided. A 1.5 litre size restriction applies.
- Small amounts of home-prepared food for personal consumption, such as sandwiches, fruit, chippies, cakes.
- Thermos flask with hot beverages.
- Food must be contained in one small bag that will fit under your seat.
- Ample food and beverage outlets are available within the Arena.

Patrons may not bring into the Central Energy Trust Arena

- Alcohol.
- Non-alcoholic beverages over 500ml (water over 1.5 litre).
- Glass bottles.
- Commercially produced food, such as McDonald's, KFC, Subway, pizza, fish and chips.
- Hard chilly bins or large bags.
- Illicit drugs.
- Musical instruments or sound amplifiers including megaphones.
- Recording devices for commercial purposes.
- Prams, strollers, pushchairs.
- Dogs or other animals (service dogs are permitted with certification).
- Flares, fireworks, laser pointers.
- Knives or other dangerous weapons.
- Skateboards, roller blades, scooters or bicycles.
- Freestanding chairs/ deck chairs.
- Signs or banners that are deemed obscene, offensive or abusive.
- Flag poles longer than one metre.
- Any other item that the Arena management determines may cause injury or public nuisance or inconvenience to any other person.

Smoking + Vaping

- The Arena is a Smokefree environment, however, smoking/vaping areas are available behind the main grandstand. Please refrain from smoking/ vaping in general public areas.

General

- For the safety and security of patrons, surveillance cameras are in use throughout the Arena.
- Patrons must not sit or stand in aisles, or block entry doors or emergency exits.
- Patrons acknowledge some sporting events and activities can be dangerous; you must make yourself aware of the risk associated.
- There are no pass outs at some events.
- Patrons with umbrellas may be asked to drop them if obstructing the view of others.
- Cameras, videos, tape recorders and other recording devices may be prohibited for certain events.
- Patrons bring personal items into the Arena at their own risk. The venue will not be held responsible for any damages to, loss or theft of a patron's personal property.
- Advertising promotions and product giveaways etc are not permitted on the Arena property (this includes the car parks at Central Energy Trust Arena) unless expressly authorised by Arena management in writing. Any unauthorised product giveaways will be confiscated.
- No alcohol is to be removed from the Arena, as you will be entering a liquor ban area.
- Children under the age of 14 must be supervised by an accompanying adult.
- By entering the Arena you agree to have your photo/video taken at events. These may be used for promotional purposes.

- He kai iti kua oti te whakarite i te kāinga, hei kai mā te tangata ake, pērā i te hanawiti, i te huarākau, i te keke me te titipi.†**
Small amounts of home prepared food for personal consumptions, including sandwiches, fruit, cake, chippies.
